REPORT ON ACADEMIC AND ADMINISTRATIVE AUDIT

The Academic and Administrative Audit for the academic year 2019 – 2020 was held on 18.03.2020 and 19.03.2020. The External Auditor was Dr.V.Balamurugan, Professor, CSE & Director, IQAC, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, Tirunelveli.

The following observations were made during the Audit:

The Department of Tamil (Aided) is offering Part – I programme to the students of all the Departments in the aided stream. The Department offers four courses and one value -added course to the students. Of the five faculty members, three of them are full - time teachers and all are doctorates. Two serve as research guides for two research scholars. The Department's average teaching experience is 18.33 years. In the academic year 2019 - 2020, eleven research articles and five chapters in various books were published. In 2016, the Department signed an MoU with The Tamil Heritage Foundation. One e-resource has been generated by the Department.

The Department of Arabic (Aided) offers B.A and four courses are offered under this programme. The Department's average teaching experience is eleven years. In the academic year 2018 - 2019, 8% of the students have pursued their higher studies. One faculty development programme has been attended.

The Research Department of English is offering B.A, M.Phil and Ph.D programmes. The Department offers twenty - six courses under B.A and four courses under M.Phil programmes in each semester. Nearly 37.3% of the courses offered focuses on improving the employability, entrepreneurship and skills of the students. So far 40.7% new courses have been introduced across all programmes offered by the Department. 100% of the students are undertaking projects as a part of their curriculum. The mentor- mentee ratio of the Department is 1:23. Of the eight faculty members, all the faculty members are full - time teachers of which 62.5% (5 out of 8) of the teachers are doctorates and they serve as research supervisors for twenty scholars. Two of them are doing Ph.D. The five research guides have been allotted seed



money from the institution for the expenditure in the field of research. Five staff members have been allotted seed money by the college management for undertaking Minor Research Projects. In the academic year 2019 - 2020, three research articles and also a book was published. The Department's average teaching experience is 10.43 years. Six students have been placed in various sectors and thirty - four students have opted for pursuing higher studies. Seven students have cleared NET, one has qualified SET and six students have cleared NPTEL exams. Ten faculty development programmes have been attended by the staff. The Department has provided the details of forty distinguished alumni. The Department has generated thirty - four e-resources.

The Department of Computer Science (Aided) is offering B.Sc and forty - two courses are offered under this programme in each semester. Fifty two percentage of the courses focuses on employability, 43% of the courses on entrepreneurship and 3% improves the skills of the students. 100% of the students indulge in undertaking UG projects. The Mentor - Mentee ratio of the Department is 1:30. Of the five faculty members, four of them are full - time teachers. Forty percentage of the teachers are doctorates and 20% were recognised as research guides. The Department's average teaching experience is 28 years. In the academic year 2018 - 2019, twelve students have been placed in varied companies and nineteen students have progressed for higher education. One faculty development programme has been attended.

The Research Department of History is offering B.A, M.A, M.Phil and Ph.D programmes. Twenty- five courses are offered under B.A and M.A programmes. 100% of the students are undertaking projects as a part of their curriculum. The mentor- mentee ratio of the Department is 1:30. Of the ten faculty members, all the faculty members are full- time teachers. Five of them are doctorates and research guides under whom fifteen scholars were awarded and two are pursuing. The Department's average teaching experience is 9.8 years. In the academic year 2019 - 2020, five research articles were published and two MoUs have been signed. In the academic year 2018 - 2019, seven students have been placed in different jobs and fourteen students have progressed for higher education. One faculty development programme has been attended. Seventeen e-resources have been generated so far.

The Research Department of Commerce is offering B.Com, M.Com, M.Phil and Ph. D programmes. Thirty- two courses under B. Com, twenty - two courses under M.Com and four courses under M. Phil programmes are offered. 40.62% of the courses focuses on employability, 18.75% of the courses on entrepreneurship and 34.38% improves the skills of the

students. 100% of the students are undertaking projects as a part of their curriculum. The mentor- mentee ratio of the Department is 1:24. Of the eleven faculty members, nine are full-time teachers of which 75% are doctorates and 44.44% serve as research guides. In the academic year 2019 - 2020, twenty - six research papers and four books were published. The Department's average teaching experience is 8.9 years. Four students have been placed in varied jobs and eighteen students have opted to pursue higher studies. Three students have qualified CA exams and six have cleared NPTEL exams. Three faculty development programmes have been attended. The Department has generated four hundred and forty-nine e-resources.

The Research Department of Mathematics offers B.Sc and Ph.D programmes. Thirty-one courses and three value-added courses are offered under B.Sc in each semester. Of the thirty-one courses in B.Sc, three are newly introduced courses. Eleven percentage of the courses focuses on employability, 11% of the courses on entrepreneurship and 3% improves the skills of the students. Four percentage of the students have undertaken field projects. Of the five faculty members, four are doctorates and serve as research guides to sixteen scholars. In the academic year 2019 - 2020, five research articles were published. The Department's average teaching experience is fourteen years. Five students have been placed in varied jobs and twenty-five students have advanced for higher education. Two faculty development programmes have been attended.

The Research Department of Chemistry is offering B.Sc and Ph.D programmes. Forty courses are offered under B.Sc in each semester. Of the forty courses in B.Sc. Ten are newly introduced courses. Sixty two percent of the courses focuses on employability, 12.5% of the courses on entrepreneurship and 25% improves the skills of the students. 100% of the students are undertaking projects as a part of their curriculum. Of the six faculty members, all are doctorates and five are research guides for twelve scholars. In the academic year 2019 - 2020, two research papers and two books were published. The Department's average teaching experience is 10 years. The Department has generated Rs. 3,500 as revenue through consultancy services. It has three collaborative activities and signed two MoUs. Four students have been placed in varied jobs and nineteen students have opted for higher education. Four faculty development programmes have been attended.

The Research Department of Zoology is offering B.Sc and forty courses are offered under this programme in each semester of which five new courses have been introduced. Of the eight faculty members, seven are doctorates and three are research guides and guiding eleven research scholars. It has two collaborative activities and signed two MoUs. A student has got

placed in a job and fourteen students have proceeded for higher education. Four faculty development programmes have been attended.

The Research Department of Physics is offering B.Sc and Ph.D programmes. Thirty-seven courses are offered under B.Sc in each semester. Twenty three percent of the courses focuses on employability, 4% of the courses on entrepreneurship and 23% improves the skills of the students. Of the six teachers, all are doctorates and three of them serve as research supervisors for five scholars. In the academic year 2019 - 2020, five research articles were published. The Department's average teaching experience is fourteen years. An MoU was signed. In the academic year 2018 - 2019, one has cleared a qualifying exam, eight students have been placed in different jobs and twenty-one have progressed for higher studies. Two faculty development programmes have been attended.

The Department of Tamil (Unaided) offers B.A and thirty-eight courses and one value-added course are offered under this programme that provides a 100% focus on employability, entrepreneurship and skill development of the students. Eighty percentage of the courses are newly introduced. All the final year students are undertaking projects as a part of their curriculum. The mentor- mentee ratio of the Department is 1:22. Of the seven faculty members, 85.71% are doctorates and 42.85% are research guides to six scholars. In the academic year 2019 -2020, nineteen research papers and seven chapters in different books were published. The Department's average teaching experience is 2.61 years. In 2019 - 2020, the Department signed an MoU with the Tamil Heritage Foundation. In the academic year 2018 - 2019, ten students have proceeded for higher education and two have cleared NPTEL exams. Two e-resources have been generated.

The Department of Arabic and Islamic Studies (Unaided) offers B.A programme. Of the seven faculty members, two are doctorates. The Department's average teaching experience is 8 years. In the academic year 2018 - 2019, four students have got placed and two have opted for pursuing higher studies.

The PG Department of English (Unaided) offers B.A and M.A programmes. Twenty-five courses under B.A and twenty courses under M.A are offered. Nearly 37% of the courses offered at the UG level and 31% of the courses offered at the PG level focuses on improving the employability, entrepreneurship and skills of the students. 40% of the courses in UG and 31% in PG are newly introduced. 100% of the final year students are undertaking projects as a part of their curriculum and 4% have attended internships. The mentor- mentee ratio of the Department

is 1:19. Of the fourteen faculty members, 28% are doctorates. In the academic year 2019 - 2020, two research papers and a chapter in a book were published. In the academic year 2018 - 2019, four students have got placed in varied jobs and nineteen students have advanced for higher education. Six students have qualified NET/SET, one has cleared Group-II exam and thirteen students have cleared NPTEL exams. One faculty development programme has been attended. Nine e-resources were generated by the staff members of the Department.

The Department of Commerce – ‘A’ offers B.Com. All the final year students are undertaking projects as a part of their curriculum. The mentor- mentee ratio of the Department is 1:40. Of the five faculty members, 40% are doctorates and 20% serve as research guides to four scholars. In the academic year 2019 - 2020, one research article was published. The Department’s average teaching experience is 5.8 years. In the academic year 2018 - 2019, eighteen students have been placed in different jobs and fourteen students have advanced for higher education. The Department has gathered details of eight distinguished alumni. Ten e-resources were created by the staff members.

The Department of Commerce – ‘B’ offers B.Com. All the final year students are undertaking projects as a part of their curriculum. The mentor- mentee ratio of the Department is 1:48. Of the four faculty members, 25% are doctorates who serve as research guides to four scholars. The Department’s average teaching experience is 7 years. In the academic year 2018 - 2019, one has qualified C.A exam, two have cleared C.S exam, nine students have been placed in different jobs and twenty students have progressed for higher education. Six e-resources have been generated by the Department staff.

The Department of Commerce – Finance offers B.Com and thirty-four courses are offered under this programme in each semester. In addition to this, type-writing course is also offered. Fourteen percentage of the courses focuses on employability, 61% of the courses on entrepreneurship and 4% improves the skills of the students. The mentor- mentee ratio of the Department is 1:50. Of the four faculty members, two are doctorates and one is a research guide to four scholars. In the academic year 2019 - 2020, eight research articles were published. The Department’s average teaching experience is six years. In the academic year 2018 - 2019, five students have advanced for higher education. One faculty development programme has been attended and twenty-four e-resources were created.

The PG and Research Department of Microbiology offers B.Sc, M.Sc and Ph.D programmes. 11.5% of the UG courses and 48.1% of the PG courses are newly proposed. Of the

seven faculty members, six are doctorates and one serve as research guide to one scholar. The College Management has allotted Rs.60,000 as seed money to six teachers concerning Minor Research Projects. In the academic year 2019 - 2020, six research articles were published. The Department has generated Rs. 1,100 as revenue through consultancy services. In the academic year 2018 - 2019, fifteen students have cleared NPTEL exams, twenty students have been placed in different jobs and 17% of the students are pursuing higher education. Seven faculty development programmes were attended. Ten e-resources were generated.

The Department of Nutrition and Dietetics offers B.Sc and forty courses and three value-added courses are offered under this programme in each semester. Twenty five percent are recently launched courses. 57.5% of the courses focuses on employability, 45% of the courses on entrepreneurship and 30% improves the skills of the students. Of the five faculty members, one is a doctorate. In the academic year 2018 - 2019, nine students have cleared NPTEL exams, six students have been placed in different jobs and three students are doing higher studies.

The PG and M.Phil Department of Computer Science offers M.Sc and M.Phil programmes. Thirty courses under M.Sc and twenty- one courses under M.Phil programmes are offered. Seventy five percentage of the courses in PG and 36% in M.Phil are newly introduced. Fifty seven percentage of the courses focuses on employability, 41.6% of the courses on entrepreneurship and 72.3% improves the skills of the students. Forty eight percentage of the students have undertaken various internships and projects. The mentor- mentee ratio of the Department is 1: 8. Of the four faculty members, one is a doctorate and a research guide and also was awarded with an international fellowship. In the academic year 2019 - 2020, seventeen research articles were published. The Department's average teaching experience is 8.5 years. The Department has collaborated with concerns for research purposes and also signed two MoUs. 40.6% of the students have been employed, 62% have progressed for higher education and 8% have cleared various competitive exams. Eight e-resources have been generated.

The PG and M.Phil Department of Mathematics offers B.Sc, M.Sc and M.Phil programmes. Twenty- nine courses under B.Sc and twenty-seven courses under M.Sc are offered. Nearly 37.93 % of the courses offered at the UG level and 96.3% of the courses offered at the PG level focuses on improving the employability, entrepreneurship and skills of the students. 15.43% of the courses in UG and 11% in PG are newly introduced. 100% of the students are undertaking projects as a part of their curriculum. The mentor- mentee ratio of the Department is 1:25. Of the seven faculty members, three are doctorates and one has been recognised as research guide. Three research articles were published in 2019 - 2020. Eleven

students have cleared NPTEL exams, and two students have progressed for higher studies. Six faculty development programmes were attended and seven e-resources were generated.

The Department of Computer Science (Unaided) offers B.Sc and forty-six courses are offered under this programme of which 35.6% courses are newly initiated. 82.6% of these courses focuses on employability, entrepreneurship and skill development of the students. 100% of the students are undertaking projects as a part of their curriculum. The mentor- mentee ratio of the Department is 1:30. The Department's average teaching experience is 7.3 years. In the academic year 2019 - 2020, two research articles were published. Three research articles were also published this year. Two students have cleared NPTEL exams, three students have been placed in various jobs and nine students have progressed for higher studies. Six faculty development programmes were attended and nine e-resources were created.

The Department of Information Technology offers B.Sc and forty-two courses are offered under this programme of which 56% courses are newly introduced. Thirty eight percentage of the courses focuses on employability, 8% of the courses on entrepreneurship and 54% improves the skills of the students. 100% of the students are undertaking projects as a part of their curriculum. The mentor- mentee ratio of the Department is 1:28. Four research articles were published in this year. Four students have cleared NPTEL exams, three students have been placed in different companies and sixteen students have progressed for higher studies. Five faculty development programmes were attended and twenty-one e-resources were created.

The Department of Computer Applications offers B.C.A and forty-six courses and three value-added courses are offered under this programme of which 40% courses are yet to be approved by the Board of Studies. 34% of the courses focuses on employability, 4% of the courses on entrepreneurship and 12% improves the skills of the students. The mentor- mentee ratio of the Department is 1:28. Of the five faculty members, one is a doctorate. In the academic year 2019 - 2020, one research article was published and the Department's average teaching experience is seven years. In the academic year 2018 - 2019, three students have cleared NPTEL exams, six students have been placed in different companies and ten students have progressed for higher studies. One faculty development programme was attended and two e-resources were generated by the Department staff.

The Department of Business Administration offers B.B.A and thirty-seven courses and one value-added course are offered under this programme. Nineteen percentage of the courses are newly introduced. Thirty five percentage of the courses focuses on employability,

15% of the courses on entrepreneurship and 50% improves the skills of the students. All the students of the final year are undertaking projects as a part of their curriculum and 4% have attended internships. The Mentor - Mentee ratio of the Department is 1:38. Of the five faculty members, one is a doctorate and has been recognised as research supervisor. The Department's average teaching experience is 4.3 years. In the academic year 2018 - 2019, nineteen students have been placed in different companies and sixteen students have proceeded for higher studies. Nine faculty development programmes were attended and five e-resources were generated by the members of the Department.


The PG Department of Physics offers M.Sc (Physics) and thirty courses and two value-added courses are offered under this programme. Nineteen percentage of the courses focuses on employability, 11% of the courses on entrepreneurship and 16% aims at improving the skills of the students. The mentor-mentee ratio of the Department is 1: 8. Of the five faculty members, three are doctorates of which two serve as research guides to seven scholars. The two research guides have been allotted seed money from the institution for the expenditure in the field of research. In the academic year 2019- 2020, seven research articles were published. The Department has collaborated with concerns for research purposes and also signed an MoU. 21% of the students have been employed, 21% have progressed for higher education and one has cleared a competitive exam.

The PG Department of Chemistry offers M.Sc (Chemistry) and thirty courses and one value-added course are offered under this programme of which two courses are newly introduced. Sixteen percentage of the courses focuses on employability, 13% of the courses on entrepreneurship and 21% focuses on improving the skills of the students. The Mentor -Mentee ratio of the Department is 1:8. All the faculty in the Department are doctorates of which two have been recognised as research guides. The Department's average teaching experience is five years. The Department has generated Rs. 1,500 as revenue through consultancy services. In the academic year 2019- 2020, two research articles were published. The Department has collaborated for research purposes and also signed an MoU. Five students have been placed in different jobs and two have opted for pursuing higher studies. Three faculty development programmes were attended by the staff of the Department.

The PG Department of Zoology offers M.Sc (Zoology) and thirty courses are offered under this programme. Twenty three percentage of the courses focuses on employability, 7% of the courses on entrepreneurship and 7% improves the skills of the students. The mentor-mentee ratio of the Department is 1: 6. Both the faculty members are doctorates and they serve research

guides to four scholars. The Department's average teaching experience is twelve years. Two research articles have been published in this academic year. The Department has two collaborative activities. Two students have got employments with various concerns. Two have progressed for higher education and one has cleared NPTEL exam. Twenty e-resources have been generated by the Department staff.

The Department of Library and Information Science offers B.Lib.I.Sc and twelve courses are offered under this programme that affords a 100% focus on employability, entrepreneurship and skill development of the students. 100% of the students are undertaking projects as a part of their curriculum. The mentor- mentee ratio of the Department is 1:12. Both the faculty of the Department are doctorates and the Department's average teaching experience is 5.5 years. A one MoU has been signed by the Department. In the academic year 2018 - 2019, two students have been employed and four students have progressed for higher studies. Three faculty development programmes were attended by the staff of the Department.

In the academic year 2019 - 2020, the Faculty of the Department have attended ten Seminars/Conferences/Workshops, published four Research papers in the Indexed /non-Indexed Journals, published two article/chapter in Edited Books. Three e-resources and Four e-content have been generated by the Department. The faculties of the Department was guiding 2 Doctoral Research Scholars. The Department has organized two Seminars/Workshops/Guest Lecture/Association Inauguration/Felicitation during this academic year. 91.30% of students have passed during this academic year. One student have cracked TNPSC Gropu-IV Examination during this academic year.

The Research Department of Chemistry is offering UG/Ph.D programme to the students in the aided stream. Of the five teachers, all are doctorates. In the academic year 2019 - 2020, the Faculty of the Department have attended eight Seminars/Conferences/Workshops, published five Research papers in the Indexed /non-Indexed Journals, published twelve articles/chapters in Edited Books. Fifty Three e-resources have been generated by the Department. The faculties of the Department was guiding 11 Doctoral Research Scholars. The Department has organized six Seminars/Workshops/Guest Lecture/Association Inauguration/Felicitation during this academic year. The Department signed an MoU with Wollega University, Ethiopia. 89.1% of students have passed during this academic year. Rs.7500/- has sanctioned for an UG Project under TNSCST Scholarship.

The Research Department of Zoology is offering UG/Ph.D programme to the students in the aided stream. Of the four teachers, three are doctorates. 
