REPORT OF THE INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL

The IQAC of our College channelizes all efforts and measures of the Institution towards promoting its holistic academic excellence. In this view the IQAC of our College aims at developing a system for conscious catalytic improvement in the overall performance of the Institution. The IQAC of our College strives to provide a good environment for learning. It envisages giving quality in all the ventures undertaken by the Institution. The IQAC gives more emphasis on revising the curriculum with a focus on need-based courses and global trends. It focuses on introducing inter-disciplinary, job-oriented and skill-based courses. It also focuses on preserving to select the subjects of their interest, introducing socially relevant extension programmes and implementing feedback mechanism.

We are glad to register that the Institutional Information for Quality Assurance, formerly known as the Letter of Intent (LOI) was submitted by the IQAC to the NAAC on 30.05.2022. The NAAC accepted the IIQA on 23.06.2022. The SSR for NAAC Reaccreditation process is to be submitted on or before 05.08.2022. The College Managing Committee has taken an initiative for the Modernization of the Laboratories and sanctioned a sum of Rs 1,40,00,000/-(One Crore and Forty lakhs) for the Modernization of Laboratories in the Departments of Physics, Chemistry, English, Zoology, Microbiology and Nutrition & Dietetics.

It gives us immense pleasure to register that the Men Sports Team of our College secured the Overall Championship for the 4th time at the Manonmaniam Sundarnar University Inter-Collegiate Sports Meet held on 17.12.2021, 18.12.2021 and 19.12.2021 at Anna Stadium, Tirunelveli.

With the same jubilation, we happily record that the Women Sports Team of our Institution secured the Overall Championship consecutively for the 5th time at the MSU Inter-Collegiate Sports Meet held on 17.12.2021, 18.12.2021 and 19.12.2021 at Anna Stadium, Tirunelveli.

It is recorded with a sincere sense of obligation and recognition the services rendered by the two retired Professors of the Sadakath Family - Dr. M. Mohamed Sathik, who put in a service of 34 years as a teaching faculty in the Department of Computer Science and as the first long-term Principal, (i.e. 11 years) and Dr .S .H. Mohamed Ameen, who served as a teaching faculty in the Department of Physics for 36 years and also held additional responsibilities such as the Dean of Sciences for 2 years and the Controller of Examination for 3 years.

DBT Star College Scheme:

The Star College Scheme was initiated by the DBT in 2008 to support Higher Education Institutions that are offering Undergraduate Programmes and to promote Science Teaching across the country. The Scheme was launched for improving critical thinking and encouraging experimental science at Under graduate levels. iii) Manitham:

A philanthropic movement named *MANITHAM*, which has been operational in the Institution since 30.8.2016, is doing a noble service to the destitute, homeless and unattended people around KTC Nagar, Samathanapuram, New Bus Stand and Palayamkottai. Such people are provided food, dress, chappals and bedsheets. During the COVID-19 lockdown, our Former Principal, Dr. M. Mohamed Sathik and Mr. Saravanel (Office Assistant), along with the *MANITHAM* team distributed food parcels, water bottles and bread packets to the homeless and the needy. A sum of Rs.96,300/- was collected from our staff members and students to help the homeless in and around Palayamkottai during the first lockdown period. One hundred and fifty people got benefitted from this service. There is a separate WhatsApp Group with the Principal as the Admin. Dr. A. Asaraf Ali, M.A., B.L., Ph.D. has volunteered to serve as the Legal Advisor. Dr. K. Feroz Khan, Assistant Professor of Microbiology is the Coordinator of Manitham.

iv) The Earn While You Learn Scheme:

Considering the poor economic status of some of our students and to promote work culture, the **Earn While You Learn Scheme** was introduced. The remuneration given to them is Rs. 100/- per day. They are made to serve in the College Office, Library, Book Depot, Canteen, Auditorium, Attendance Department, the Office of the IQAC, Zoology Laboratory, Microbiology Laboratory and the Department of Physical Education. A total of 26 students from both shifts have been deputed to work in various Offices, Departments and Laboratories, this year. Students belonging to the Morning Shift work during the Evening hours and vice-versa.

NSS REPORT FOR THE YEAR 2021 – 2022

The National Service Scheme (NSS) of our College is functioning in 6 units (3 units for boys and 3 units for girls) under the guidance of the Programme Officers: Mr.D.Mohideen Pillai (Unit 11), Dr.Yunush Ahamed Sherif (Unit 12), Dr. M. Abdul Rahman (Unit 13), Dr.P. Geetha,(Unit 14), Dr.M. Syed Ali Fathima (Unit 152) and Dr.M. Mariammal (Unit 151). These Officers plan the NSS regular activities and special camping programmes as per the Programme guidelines issued by the Government of India and the Programme Coordinator of the Parent University. With its varied functionings, the NSS Units of our VCollege develop among the Volunteers a sense of civic and social responsibility.

1. Covid Vaccination Camp (02.09.2021)
