The National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) approved by the MHRD and launched by Honourable Minister of Human Resource Development outlines a methodology to rank institutions across the country. The draws overall recommendations methodology from the and broad understanding arrived at by a Core Committee set up by MHRD, to identify the broad parameters for ranking various universities and institutions. NSS
