THE INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL REPORT

The plan of action chalked out by the IQAC towards quality enhancement and the outcome:

A two day Faculty Development Programme on “Emotional Intelligence” organized by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Sadakathullah Appa College in collaboration with ICTACT (ICT Academy of Tamilnadu) was held at the college seminar hall on 20.10.2016. Professionals from the ICTACT Mr. Arunkumar, Mr. Nirmal and Ms. Kalpana were the resource persons. 13 newly recruited staff members and 20 heads of various departments got benefited.

NAAC sponsored two day National Seminar on “Quality Enhancement in the Contemporary Higher Education Scenario”, organised by the IQAC of Sadakathullah Appa College was held on 07.02.2017 and 08.02.2017 at the college seminar hall. Honourable Vice Chancellor of Manonmaniam Sundaranar University Dr. Krishnan Baskar delivered the Inaugural Address. Dr. B.S. Madhukar, Adviser, NAAC Bengaluru was the chief guest for the valedictory session and delivered the valedictory address.

Dr. Selvam Jesiah, Dean, Research, Alliance University, Bengaluru Dr. V. Ambedkar, Associate Professor of Education, DDE, Annamalai University, Cuddalore Dr. M.K. Baby, IQAC Coordinator of St. Joseph's College, Devagiri, Calicut and Dr. William Dharmaraja, Head of the Educational Department, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University were the resource persons. A sum of rupees eighty three thousand was sanctioned by NAAC for the conduct of the seminar.

A Special Lecture on "Challenges in undertaking Minor and Major research projects from UGC and other Funding Agencies" organised by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell of Sadakathullah Appa College was held at the college seminar hall on 03.09.2016. Dr. A. John De Britto, Registrar, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University was the resource person.

A new facility for the staff members to update their profiles online on the college website has been initiated. So this enables the staff to edit and update their details regarding academic advancements every now and then.

Part - A

Objectives – Academic:

1. To encourage the staff members to apply for Minor and Major Research Project from UGC and other funding agencies.

IQAC organized a special lecture on “Challenges in undertaking Minor and Major research Projects from UGC and other funding agencies” on 03.09.2016 with Dr. A. John De Britto, Registrar, Manonmaniam Sundaranar University as the Resource Person.

2. To start B.A. Economics, B.A. Geography and B.Sc. Psychology.
3. To conduct orientation programme to motivate the newly appointed faculty members.

IQAC in association with ICT Academy, Chennai organized a Two day Orientation programme on “Emotional Intelligence” for the newly appointed faculty members and the Heads of various departments (Unaided) on 20.10.2016 & 21.10.2016. Nearly 33 staff members and 3 faculty from Wawoo Wajeeth Women’s College, Kayalpattinam got benefitted.

4. To conduct training programme for non-teaching faculty on ICT.
The programme is to be conducted on March 2017.

Objectives - Non-Academic

1. To construct washroom for physically challenged students in the ground floor. It is under consideration.
2. To initiate a humane programme “Manitham”

A philanthropic movement has been started in our college named **MANITHAM** on 22nd February, 2017 with a noble cause to help and pamper people who are mentally ill in and around Tirunelveli. Around 37 students have volunteered to join this movement. A separate whatsapp group which has the Principal as the admin is in place. Dr. A. Asaraf Ali, M.A., B.L., Ph.D. has volunteered to serve as the legal advisor to the movement. Despite the fact that the organization has been started only a few days ago, around 17 mentally ill people have been identified and taken care of. They have been given food, refreshments and clothes.

3. To appoint a full time staff with M.S.W. qualification with the view to strengthening the Sadakath Outreach Programme and make the programme compulsory for all the II year students from the academic year 2017-18 onwards.
4. To motivate the eminent sports students by providing them scholarships.
A good number of scholarships is being disbursed.
5. To construct staff refreshment room in the canteen.
Resolved to construct a staff refreshment room in the first floor of the existing canteen.
6. To provide 4G-Jammers in all the floors of the hostels.
Resolved to provide 4G-Jammers first in the Ladies hostels and then in the Gents hostel.
7. To install CCTV cameras in the II Floor of the college.
Resolved to install CCTV Cameras in the second floor of the College.

Part – B
