REPORT OF THE INTERNAL QUALITY ASSURANCE CELL

The IQAC of our college channelizes all efforts and measures of the institution towards promoting its holistic academic excellence. In this view the IQAC of our college aims at developing a system for conscious catalytic improvement in the overall performance of the institution. The IQAC of our college strives to provide a good environment for learning. It envisages giving Quality in all the ventures undertaken by the institution. The IQAC gives more emphasis on revising the curriculum with a focus on need-based courses and global trends. It focuses on introducing inter-disciplinary, job-oriented and skill-based courses. It also focuses on preserving to select the subjects of their interest, introducing socially relevant extension programmes and implementing feedback mechanism.

It is indeed a great privilege for Sadakathullah Appa College to obtain the 70th Rank with an 'A' Grade at the All India Level in offering the NPTEL Online Certification courses from January 2020 to December 2020.

Our Institution was also recognized by NPTEL as the "Best Local Chapter in Arts, Science and Commerce Category" and obtained the 6th Rank among the top 100 Local Chapters in offering the NPTEL Online Certification Courses from January 2020 to December 2020.

The tenure of the III cycle of NAAC Accreditation of our college expired on 14.11.2020. The Self Study Report (SSR) for NAAC Reaccreditation was not submitted due to the COVID-19 lockdown. Since the lockdown was in place from 25.03.2020, an extension and grace period of six months has been availed. The Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for 2019 – 2020 was not submitted due to the change of the policy by the Government of Tamil Nadu concerning the Arrear results. The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) has been convening regular meetings in connection with the preparation of NAAC SSR. With the cooperation and able support of all the staff members, the IIQA will be submitted during the third week of April. It may be noted that the staff

members are assigned the election duty by the Government of Tamil Nadu. The Annual Quality Assurance Report (AQAR) for 2019 – 2020 has already been prepared and will be submitted after the publication of the arrear results. The Honorable staff members of Dhananjayrao Gadgil College of Commerce, Satara visited our institution on 23.02.2021. They visited the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC), Controller of Examinations (CoE) Office, Deans' Office and the Digital Learning Centre (DLC). They had a vibrant and healthy interaction with our faculty members and lauded the overall efforts of our college.

The National Institutional Ranking Framework (NIRF) is a framework that outlines a methodology to rank institutions across the country. It was recommended at the IQAC Steering Committee Meeting held on 08.01.2021 to take necessary steps to feature among top 200 institutions in NIRF. The application for NIRF was submitted on 19.02.2021. This time we hope that Sadakathullah Appa College will obtain a high position in the rankings.

Atal Ranking of Institutions on Innovation Achievements (ARIIA) is an initiative of Ministry of Education (MoE), Government of India to systematically rank all major higher educational institutions and universities in India on indicators related to “Innovation and Entrepreneurship Development” amongst students and faculties. We have planned to apply for ARIIA ranking and to submit the report on 25.03.2021.

9. To establish systems and procedures for maintaining and utilizing physical, academic and support facilities such as laboratories, computers, classrooms, sports complex, etc.

Recommendations:

1. It was recommended to take necessary steps to feature among top 200 institutions in NIRF.
2. It was also recommended to strengthen the conduct of the Outreach Programmes.
3. It was recommended to purchase a camera for taking Geo-tagged photographs.
4. It was recommended to celebrate the Golden Jubilee Celebrations in a grand manner for one year and to conduct the valedictory session at the end of the year.
5. It was recommended to train the students before eliciting feedback from them, so as to get good percentage of positive responses. A separate box may be maintained to collect the grievances at the time of training.
6. It was recommended that an indepth analysis of the feedback may be done. Verbatim of the responses may be collected and addressed to.
7. It was recommended to continue the online mode of offering certain features of the programmes and the courses.
8. It was recommended that more number of professional courses like B.Com. Honours may be introduced.
9. It was recommended that training for ICWA and CA may be offered.
10. It was recommended that tie-up with foreign universities may be initiated.
11. It was recommended to educate the students about the strengths of the institution.
12. It was recommended that seminars on corporate affairs may be conducted.
