A General Medical Camp was organized on 19.08.2017 in Santhaipeitai village and an Ayurvedic Medical Camp was organized on 08.04.2017 in Omanallur village.

Sadakath Outreach Programme is an Extension service of our college. It was started in the year 2009. It is a compulsory programme for all the II year UG students. Each department has one staff-in-charge for this programme. Our college has adopted six villages, namely, Burkitmanagaram, Sandapettai, Keelanatham (Therkur), Keelanatham (Vadakur), Meyakhanpalli and Syedunganallur. Dr. M. Sheik Muhideen Badhusa (Department of Chemistry), Prof. Mohamed Imran, (Department of Business Administration) and Dr. Jesuraj (Department of Commerce, Unaided) are the coordinators. Ms. A. Ramya is the Team-manager of Sadakath Outreach Programme. All the staff members who led the students team were staff-incharge of SOP. The following programmes were organized by the SOP from July 2017 to August 2017.

1. Totally 33 Girl students and 3 staffs from the Departments of Tamil, Computer Science and Commerce (CA) conducted a survey at Burkitmanagaram village on 31.07.2017. The people suffer from water scarcity and malfunction of street lights. They are interested in starting Small Scale Industries.
2. Totally 38 girl students and 4 staffs from the Departments of Computer Applications, Information Technology and Commerce (Unaided) conducted a survey at Meyakhanpalli village on 02.08.2017.

The people reported the menace of reptiles and mosquito-bites. They requested the SOP volunteers to help in getting their Voter ID. They wanted to learn craft works for their livelihood.

3. A total of 32 girl students and one staff from the Department of Maths (Unaided) conducted a survey at Keelanatham (Therkur) village on 03.08.2017. They asked for a separate water tank and they wanted the street lights to be repaired.
4. Totally 30 girl students and one staff from the Department of Zoology (Aided) conducted a survey at Keelanatham (Vadakur) village on 04.08.2017. They wanted a separate water tank. They wanted street lights. The village has poor sanitary conditions. There is a library with no books. They wanted to equip the library. They showed interest in mushroom cultivation.
5. A total of 45 girl students and one Staff from the Department of English (Aided) surveyed the syedinganallur village on 07.08.2017. Water scarcity is the major problem in the village.
6. A special medical camp was organized in sandapettai village on 19.08.2017. Nearly 75 Village people were benefited from this Medical camp. Blood pressure and Diabetes level of the locals were tested. Totally 33 boy students and one staff from the Department of History participated in this medical camp.
7. A Programme to distribute Nilavembu decoction at Syedunganallur village was organized on 29.08.2017. Dr. Subash chandran M.D(s), (Govt. Siddha Medical College, Palayamkottai) distributed Nilavembu Decoction to the village people. Around 200 village people got benefited. A total of 35 girl students and one staff from the Department of Nutrition and Dietetics were participated in this programme.
