Premier Systems has agreed to take charge of the said e-waste and collect, remove and dispose the same from the College located at Rahmath Nagar, Tirunelveli, in the manner prescribed by the concerned authorities on the following terms and conditions agreed to between the parties.

Scope of the Service

The College agrees to provide e-waste and the agency agrees to take charge of the disposed e-waste.

The College shall, at its sole discretion, send written intimation regarding the collection of e-waste to the Premier Systems either at a specified interval of time or whenever specified quantity of e-waste is generated. The said e-waste shall be collected from the College premises within 30 working days of intimation or any other period as required by the company. It will be the responsibility of the Premier Systems to collect the same from the premises and have the same transported from College to Premier Systems facility at its own costs & expenses in accordance with the guidelines and procedures prescribed by applicable authorities/laws and instructions of the College.

3 Exchange of Information and Documents



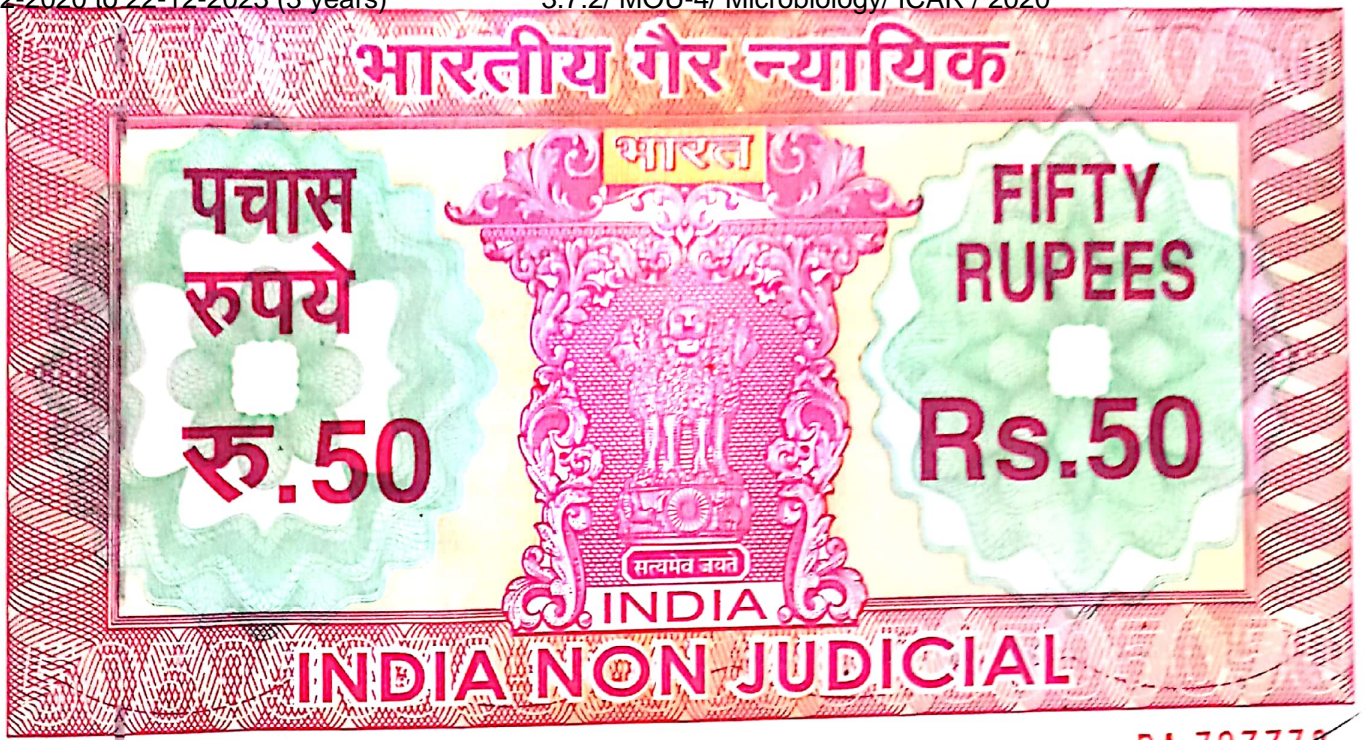

Both the parties have decided to agree to establish Bioenergy unit from waste materials and academic collaboration in areas of mutual interest and in accordance with terms and conditions set forth in this Memorandum of Understanding.

The FIRST PARTY and the SECOND PARTY agree on the following activities;

- The SECOND PARTY will provide support to conduct programmes related with Biogas technology and vermi-composting. To achieve this, senior official from the SECOND PARTY will work in close collaboration with the faculty members of the FIRST PARTY.
- The SECOND PARTY will offer internship to the students of the FIRST PARTY, so that the students get hands on experience of live projects.
- The SECOND PARTY will provide internship to the students but the second party will not disclose the research activities to the FIRST PARTY students and staffs.
- The number of students, who can be considered for hands on training and internship would be mutually decided between the SECOND PARTY and the FIRST PARTY every year with possible nominal cost.
- The FIRST PARTY will arrange periodic field visits for the faculty and the students, in the SECOND PARTY project sites to enable them to get practical exposure and learning from interaction with members or project teams of the SECOND PARTY.
- Each party will appoint one nodal officer to review periodical and identify ways to strengthen co-operation between them.
- The FIRST PARTY will arrange and offer training programmes in the area identified by both parties.
- The members of the SECOND PARTY will take part in the conferences, seminars and workshops conducted by the FIRST PARTY for the sharing of updated knowledge. The staff and students of the FIRST PARTY will also take part in the conferences, seminars and workshops conducted by the SECOND PARTY.
- As per the interaction between both parties, will be creating programme coordination committee constituted by the signatory of the MOU, for regular monitoring of activities and achieving set targets. The committee will meet & assess the activities in regular intervals to review the progress.

- The SECOND PARTY research activities and any form of data will not be published by FIRST PARTY as this research centre is fully funded by ICAR and their research outcomes should be submitted to the council at ICAR head quarters every year.
- The SECOND PARTY will support and provide services in the field of renewable energy (biogas technology) at the site of FIRST PARTY only if the funds and expenses for the technology establishment are incurred by the FIRST PARTY


