Alhaj.T.E.S.Fathu Rabbani, Secretary and Correspondent of the Managing Committee, presided over the meeting. The Imam of the College Mosque, recited verses from the Holy Quran. The Condolence

Resolution on the demise of Alhaj. P.S.A. Pallak Lebbe, President of the Managing Committee, was executed by Alhaj.T.E.S.Fathu Rabbani. In his report, he remembered with reverence and fondness the four decades of the President's contributions to the College as a Treasurer and President. He mentioned how the President was known for his keen interest in participating in the Governing Board Meetings, giving valuable suggestions and asking pertinent questions for the welfare of the Institution. The Secretary remarked that the loss was not only to the Governing Board, but also to the College. He also prayed for the emancipation of his soul.


Alhaj.T.E.S.Fathu Rabbani, the Secretary, then welcomed the members present at the meeting. He extended a special welcome to Dr.D.Gnanasundaram, the Vice-Chairperson, Central Institute of Classical Tamil, Chennai, and UGC Nominee, who attended the meeting online. The Secretary then informed the Board about the six vacancies that were to be approved by the Director of Collegiate Education. He then made mention of the unusual situation caused by the COVID-19 pandemic and the inconvenience in conducting the inaugural ceremony to celebrate the Golden Jubilee in the Academic Year (2021-2022) in a grand manner as per the plan. He expressed his sincere regards to the retired members of staff of Sadakathullah Appa College, who had agreed to take up the project of laying roads on the College campus at a cost of Rs.25,00,000/-. He was equally grateful to the Alumni Association of Sadakathullah Appa College, which had promised to put up an arch amounting to Rs.25,00,000/-.

The Secretary also spoke of the need for the purchase of an integrated Computer Software Programme that would interconnect the College Office, the COE Office, the Deans' Office, the IQAC Office, the Library and the Attendance Department. He expressed his hope that the College would secure a rank in the NIRF Ranking 2021. In this

regard, he asked the Principal to pay a visit to Krishnammal College, Coimbatore, and Lady Doak College, Madurai. The Secretary then pointed out that the College had not received any Autonomous grant for the past two years. He finally thanked all the participants for their presence at the meeting.

Dr.S.Mahadevan, Dean of Arts, read out the minutes and the resolutions of the Governing Board Meeting held on 09.12.2020. Following him, Dr.S.M.Abdul Kader, Dean of Sciences, presented the minutes and resolutions of the Academic Council Meeting held on 20.3.2021. In connection with the first resolution: presentation of the draft resolutions of the respective Board of Studies Meetings along with the approval of the revised Programme Objectives (POs), Programme Specific Objectives (PSOs) and Course Objectives (COs), brought forth by various Department Representatives, the Principal called attention to the commendable contributions of the two Deans, Dr.S.Mahadevan and Dr.S.M. Abdul Kader, for the past three years. He made mention of how the syllabi during their tenure needed to be framed in a new format, incorporating the guidelines of the Tamil Nadu State Council for Higher Education (TANSICHE), University Grants Commission (UGC) – Learning Outcomes Based Curriculum Framework (LOCF) and Manonmaniam Sundaranar University, the University to which the College is affiliated, along with Programme Learning Objectives, Programme Specific Objectives, Course Objectives, Course Outcomes and Relationship Matrix, and how they together worked day and night to accomplish the task. Relating to the second resolution: recommendation for the introduction of new courses B.Sc.Psychology and M.Sc. Nutrition and Dietetics in the Unaided category from the academic year 2021-2022.
