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P.G. Board of Studies in English

The first meeting of the newly constituted Board of Studies for P.G. English was conducted in the E-Conference hall of our college on Wednesday, 25th February, 2015. All the members of the Board including the two Subject experts, University Representative, Alumni Representative and an Industrialist were present. The meeting began with a welcome address by the H.O.D (P.G.) and Chairman of the Board. Resolution Passed:

The Board members discussed the finalisation of the proposed new Syllabus to be introduced for Students joining M.A. English in July 2015 and onwards for a period of three years. The Board satisfied the Course Structure first. It introduced many changes in the existing Syllabus, with the CBCs pattern of 18 core bubjects, one NME paper and another Core Elective paper.

Altogether, 20 papers were proposed for the four Semesters. Guidelines issued by TRAC were followed for framing Guidelines issued by TRAC were followed for framing.

While continuing the traditional Core papers
like British Literature \hat{N} papers, Indian writing in English,
Canadian Literature, American Literature and Common Wealth
Literature, many modifications and improvements were
suggested and accepted. Regarding the Language papers,
in addition to the paper on the History of English
Language, a paper on English Language Teaching was
introduced.

The usual paper on Journalism was totally sexised with the introduction of a modern text for Print and Electronic Media. In addition to the usual Research Methodology, new papers like Feminist writing, Contemporary Indo-English Fiction and New Literatures in English were introduced, there by making the new Syllabus innovative for English Learners. For NME paper a new paper on English for Business Communication was finalised. Regarding the project, all necessary guidelines were suggested to make the Dissertation meaningful.

On the whole, all the members participated

-133 in the healthy discussion by giving valuable opinions. M. Phil English Resolved to request the management to Start M. Phil English. The Same Board introduced a new syllabus for the proposed M. Phil English course to be introduced in July 2016. The following papers were finalised: 1. Critical Theory I Sem 2. Research Methodology & Thesis writing. 3. Area papers: Literature in Translation OR Contemporary Global Fiction II Sem. 4. Dissertation × Viva Voce All the relevant details unitwise were discussed threadbase and special guidelines for Dissertation were finalised. The one year course covers the above said papers.
