







The following Suggestions are made by Board of studies members in the Present M.Phil Syllabus.

- ✓ The Board resolved to add two New Courses titled '*Fundamentals of Indian Epigraphy*' and '*Principles and Methods of Archaeology*'.



- ✓ The Board recommended to add Bhopal Gas Tragedy with the Course titled '*Environmental History*'


