The following are the other conditions that shall be complied with:

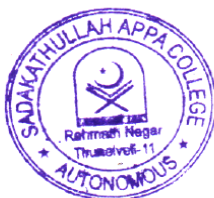
- The financial assistance should be utilized for the purpose for which it has been sanctioned.
