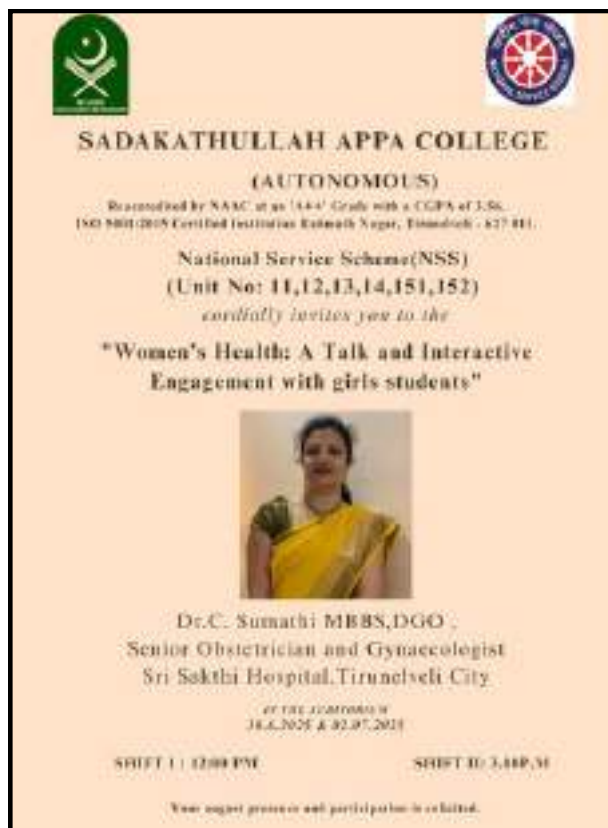



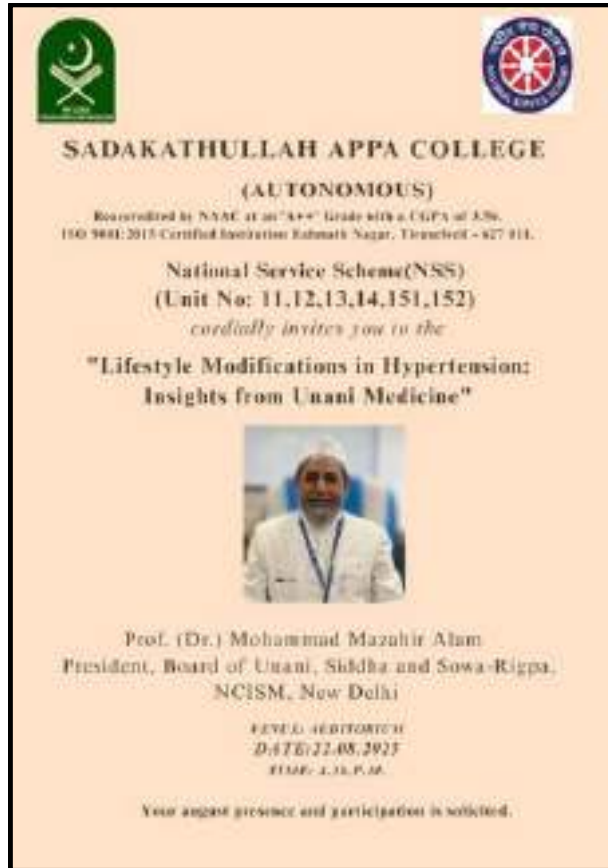

Exposure Visit Science Students – 14.10.2025



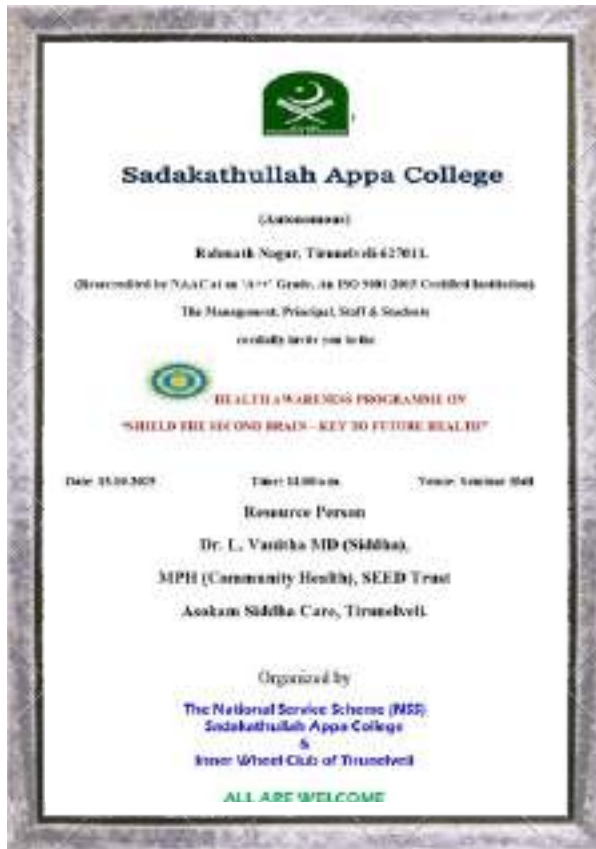
